Tommy G Productions' Last Man Standing will host sixteen amateur fighters in a single elimination tournament for a guaranteed purse of \$5,000. There will be two weight classes for male fighters. Lightweight participants must weigh between 150 lbs and 185 lbs and heavyweight competitors must weigh 185.1 lbs and above. There will also be a single weight class (165 lbs and less) female bout during the evening. Bouts shall consist of three (3) rounds: 1st Round is 1 minute 30 seconds with the 2 and 3rd Round lasting one (1) minute with one (1) minute rest periods between each round. Each round will be judged on a ten (10) point must system.

The Colorado State Boxing commission regulates the event and all fighters meet the following requirements.

- Must be 21 years and older
- Have no previous professional boxing or kickboxing experience and have no more than five (5) sanctioned amateur boxing wins over the last five (5) years.
- 16 oz boxing gloves shall be worn by all participants
- Applications for event are available by visiting www.tommygproductions.com.
- Only completed application forms will be accepted. Forms may be mailed to Tommy G Productions: 23344 Hwy 50 East, Pueblo, CO 81006 or emailed to tommygproductions@comcast.net and must be received by February 25 at 5:00 pm MST to be considered for draw. Applications received via the internet will be sent a confirmation by Tommy G Productions.
- Must be licensed by the Colorado Boxing Commission and cleared by the Director and a licensed physician a minimum of 12 days prior to the event to participate.
- A \$130 entry fee must be paid by cash only once a fighter has been drawn on February 28th, 2009.
- Corner men will be provided for each contestant

Eight male fighters in each weight division, two female contestants and four alternates will be drawn for the Last Man Standing event on February 28, 2009. Location and time of press conference/draw to be announced. All applicants must be in attendance of the draw. Fighters drawn on February 28 will be required to pay a fee of \$130 immediately following the draw to be considered for the event. All fighters are subject to approval of Boxing Commission, physician's release and official weigh in to be added to the event fight card.

Event Rules and Regulations

In addition to the Colorado State Boxing Commission rules and regulations for Elimination Tournaments, the following rules will be enforced.

1. Fighters must be 21 years and older to participate. Fighters must provide one form of photo identification verifying date of birth at the time of the draw.
2. There will be two weight divisions for the male participants, eight fighters per weight class. Lightweight 185 lbs and less and Heavyweight 185.1 lbs and above. There will be only one bout for female fighters with a weight group of 165 lbs and less.

CHAPTER 11 - ELIMINATION TOURNAMENTS

11.001 General Rules Applicable

All general rules, where appropriate, also apply to elimination tournaments.

11.002 Glove Size

At least sixteen ounce boxing gloves shall be worn by all participants.

11.003 Equipment

The Promoter shall provide headgear which shall be worn by all contestants. Each contestant must have 2 Mouthpieces and wear a groin protector.

Promoters of elimination tournaments may request that the Commission not accept a participant due to conduct or safety. Upon approval of the request by the Commission, the participant in question shall be banned from participating in the event.

11.004 Rounds and Time Length

Elimination tournament bouts shall consist of three (3) one (1) minute rounds with a one (1) minute rest period between each round. Each round will be judged on a ten (10) point must system.

11.005 Format

Elimination tournaments shall be single elimination events. A participant who has lost a bout may not participate in another bout in same event.

11.006 3 Knockdown Rule

If a participant is knockdown three (3) times in a round, that participant shall be declared the loser of the bout.

11.007 Stoppage of a Bout

The referee or the ringside physician may stop a bout if, in their judgement, the continuation of the bout may jeopardize the health or the safety of a participant.

11.008 Elimination Tournaments - -Length - - Registration

Elimination tournaments are one (1) day event. Elimination tournament participants may not participate in more than four matches. Also Elimination tournament participants must be registered and cleared by the Director and a licensed physician a minimum of 12 days prior to the event to participate.

11.009 Participant's Age

Participants must be at least eighteen (18) years of age.

11.010 Proof of Age

Participants must provide the Commission with one form of photo with identification verifying their date of birth.

A participant may not participate if the participant has:
been issued a Boxers Federal Identification Card;
been a competitor in professional kickboxing; or
been a winner of more than five (5) of any combination of amateur boxing, kickboxing, or elimination tournament events in the past five (5) years or more than three (3) in the past twelve (12) months, unless the event is restricted to winners of previous events

No participant shall be allowed to participate if he/she is under the influence of alcohol or drugs. The Commission may require elimination tournament participants to submit to an alcohol breathalyzer test at any time.

A participant shall not wear contact lenses, dentures, or removable dental work of any kind. A participant with dental braces may compete if the participant wears a fitted mouthpiece covering the entire brace.

11.011 Ringside Physician Responsibilities

Before a contest, the ringside physician shall administer pre-bout medical examinations to all participants. The ringside physician shall be a medical doctor (MD) or doctor of osteopathy (DO).

11.012 Unfit Participants

If the ringside physician determines that a participant is unfit to compete for any reason, that participant shall not participate in the elimination tournament.

11.013 Ringside Equipment

Each promoter shall provide all of the following:

- A public address system;
- A separate dressing room for both genders, if participants of both genders are participating;
- A separate room for physical examinations; and
- A separate dressing room shall be provided for officials.

11.014 Weight Categories

There shall be two (2) weight classes for male and female participants:

- (1) Light heavyweight - up to 185 lbs.
- (2) Heavyweight - over 185 lbs. or more.

The promoter may add additional weight categories to the program of bouts if participants in other categories apply to compete upon approval by the Commission. The Director may create weight classes other than listed above.

11.015 Female Participants

Female participants shall:

- provide a negative pregnancy test;
- not engage in a bout with a male participant;
- wear a breast protector.
